Neighbor & Block Connections and Communication:

- **The Tactic:**
 - Knock on doors and make a flyer for an event to connect with other neighbors.
 - Gather in person to connect with each other and get to know each other. Talk about what is going on and about how you want to respond together to protect people.
 - Gather Contact Information for people on your block(s). Keep a physical copy as a backup.
 - Create neighborhood text groups for communication. Develop protocols and agreements for how they will be used. [See Texting tools at the bottom of this document]

Audible Emergency Alerts:

 - Using whistles and car horns to alert community members to a threat and to quickly call in nearby responders
 - Bulk Ordering Whistles, Community & Neighborhood Giveaways, and Whistle Trainings

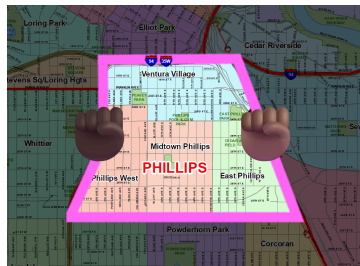

Tracking Federal Agents:

- **The Tactic:**
 - Provide information to the public about Federal activity to document and track patterns of behavior.

Lowering the Comfort & Raising the Internal Moral Tension and Psychological Pressure of Agents

- **The Tactic:**
 - Engaging with Agents who are participating in abduction and abuse, **and with their communities**, to increase their internal and external tensions and pressures
 - Increase the cost of Agents' continued compliance with violent acts and authoritarianism
 - Connection through relationship: Increasing Agents' own natural human desire to not cooperate with the abduction regime and to defect or strategically not comply.

Increasing the Tension on Politicians and Corporations that are backing, supporting, or profiting off of Trump / MAGA

- **The Tactic:**
 - **Government:** Office Visits, anti-campaign actions, protest or visibility actions, publicizing donors
 - **Corporations and the 1%:** Pressure campaigns, boycotts, call-outs, visits to corporate offices and CEOs / Boards, actions at stores, negative reviews and publicity

Art, Song, Culture, and Popular Consciousness Raising for resistance and noncooperation:

- **The Tactic:**
 - Make it widely known and visible everywhere that your community does not welcome invasion and is in active resistance to it. Build the radical collective consciousness, willingness, and commitment to act and take risks as part of a larger movement. Spread the ideas of resistance into every home and every block. Expand our shared imagination, vision, and belief in what is possible and make non-cooperation and joining the resistance common sense and irresistible.

Individuals and groups within the belly of the beast and adjacent Institutions gumming up the work of abduction, abuse, and authoritarianism

- **The Tactic:**

- Tactical Incompetence and non-compliance: being slow, extending the amount of time things take, losing important things and documents, misunderstanding things, being forgetful, sharing incorrect information, misdirecting communications like phone calls and emails, getting sick or taking mental health days at key moments, taking extended vacations and leaves, redirecting resources, setting up bureaucratic hurdles, flagging abuses, filing complaints, jamming up printers, buildings losing power or internet access, building mistrust and envy across the leadership and decision-makers, causing internal chaos.
- Finding trusted partners within your institution to build and fortify support, track and map what is happening, and to try not to get singled out, caught, or fired.
- Sharing key information carefully with trusted community actors.
- Saying no to the worst of the abuses.
- Public whistle-blowing to the media
- Publicly quitting & strategically quitting together

Any and every employee or organization:

- It is strategic to stop the rise of authoritarianism. Everyone's work and life will be much more difficult under conditions of increasing authoritarianism.
- Pivot your work and focus in condoned or not condoned ways to participate in the mass movement to protect people and build networks and infrastructure to grow our collective capacity and will to take risks and change our conditions.
- Move your organization to pivot focus, take a stand, take strategic risks, and commit resources and people-power in an on-going way.

City-wide and State-wide Popular Resistance Coordination, Orientation, and Support Structures:

- **The Tactic:**
 - City-wide community organizing and alignment across occupied cities or geography coupled with specific demands.
 - Push for decisive changes in the conditions, and the policies and laws that affect the conditions that you are working within - as close to the root as you can build the power to achieve.
 - Under Invasion: Daily multilingual Zoom calls and grounding spaces in the morning (or multiple offerings) for people to drop into and connect and get information - and get moral, psychological, cultural, and spiritual resourcing to do what they feel called to do and to know where to find support, resources, and strategic opportunities.
